

ORDINANCE NO. 0-2002-3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CISCO  
ADOPTING AN ADDITIONAL DEFINITION OF  
DANGEROUS DOG; AND ESTABLISHING AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CISCO, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The general laws of the State, except as specifically provided through proper ordinances and regulations of the City, shall control the handling of dangerous dogs. There is adopted as part of this ordinance all the provisions of Title 10, Chapter 822, Subchapter D of the Texas Health and Safety Code insofar as applicable.

SECTION 2: For purposes of this ordinance, the following words and/or phrases shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them by statute except as provided below:

(2) "Dangerous Dog" as defined in Sect. 822.041 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, is amended to include the additional definition of:

(a) Makes an unprovoked attack on a domestic animal that causes serious bodily injury or death and occurs in a place other than an enclosure in which the dog was being kept, and that was reasonably certain to prevent the dog from leaving the enclosure on its own.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall become effective upon its final passage.
